Named after Saint Pope John Paul II, who loved to minister to young people in the outdoors, Camp Wojtyla is a Catholic Adventure program currently located on 1,200 pristine acres of wilderness in the heart of the Colorado Rockies. We believe that adventure experiences can be one of the most powerful tools for self-discovery and both personal and spiritual growth.

Whether it's taking a leap of faith in the highline or persevering while climbing up a 13,000 foot mountain, our campers encounter opportunities for growth in the midst of God's glorious creation.

Everything at Camp Wojtyla is designed to create future saints! Our intentional program objectives give each camper opportunities to:

- Experience God's love through His creation
- Encounter Christ and His Church in the Sacraments
- Foster authentic Christ-centered relationships
- Follow Christ's model of servant leadership
- Understand their true identity as a son or daughter of God

At Camp Wojtyla we seek to integrate the Catholic faith with adventure, and with our 1:2 counselor to camper ratio, we're able to really dive into meaningful and memorable conversations that lead us back to our faith. We strive to bring out the best in each camper—and bring each person into a closer relationship with God.



# A Time of Growth



Camp Wojtyla runs twenty different single-gender summer sessions for various age groups and types of adventure including a Middle School Wilderness Adventure, High School Alpine Adventure, High School Outpost Adventure, and High School Backcountry Expeditions. Since 2020, Camp Wojtyla has grown 90% now serving 600 campers with over 4,000 camper days annually. The Holy Spirit is truly evident in our ministry and guiding us to exponential growth!

Our growth isn't just limited to camp attendance. Since 2007, 9 women and 2 men have entered religious life, 14 men have been ordained priests, and 17 more men are currently in seminary. The Spirit is truly moving at camp!



# The Vision

Camp has experienced tremendous growth in recent years. However, now is not the time to rest on our laurels. Camp Wojtyla is embarking on an audacious plan for the future as the mission has never been more relevant and attractive for transformative experiences for our young people. The Church consistently asks for renewal and requires vibrant organizations like Camp Wojtyla to engage in the New Evangelization by fostering deep, meaningful, spiritual experiences that lead to vocations to religious life and life-long Catholic disciples!

Guided by the Holy Spirit and led by our love for the Lord, we have been given a once in a generation opportunity. We have the opportunity to purchase an existing camp near our current leased location that is larger and better suited to meet our needs now and in the future. The time for bold action and deep faith to pursue excellence is now!

# Opportunities

The campaign for Camp Wojtyla will raise funds to purchase a new piece of property in close proximity to our current location. This new property will transform our organization and will allow for long term growth and sustainability.

This land purchase and expansion will allow the mission to continue for generations, create opportunity for growth in programming and attendance, eliminate current lease vulnerability, and streamline programmatic and logistical efficiencies. By acquiring this property, Camp Wojtyla will be able to:

- Increase Basecamp programming by 4-6 teepees (potential for additional 360 campers for a summer season!)
- Increase Outpost Program
- Add fall and spring family programming
- Create additional offseason revenue potential

## Setting Up for Long Term Success

Beyond the acquisition and campaign, this land purchase has the potential to set Camp Wojtyla up for generational success and improved financial stability. Our overall financial position would drastically improve due to:

- \* Reallocating roughly \$100,000 in current budgeted expenses currently reserved for existing land-related expenses such as our lease, etc.
- The projected revenue opportunities. The new property increases our income significantly, while our expenses are projected to remain stable.
- \* Additional revenue which will offset the current operational expenses. This will make the acquisition of property an investment that leads to long term sustainability.
